

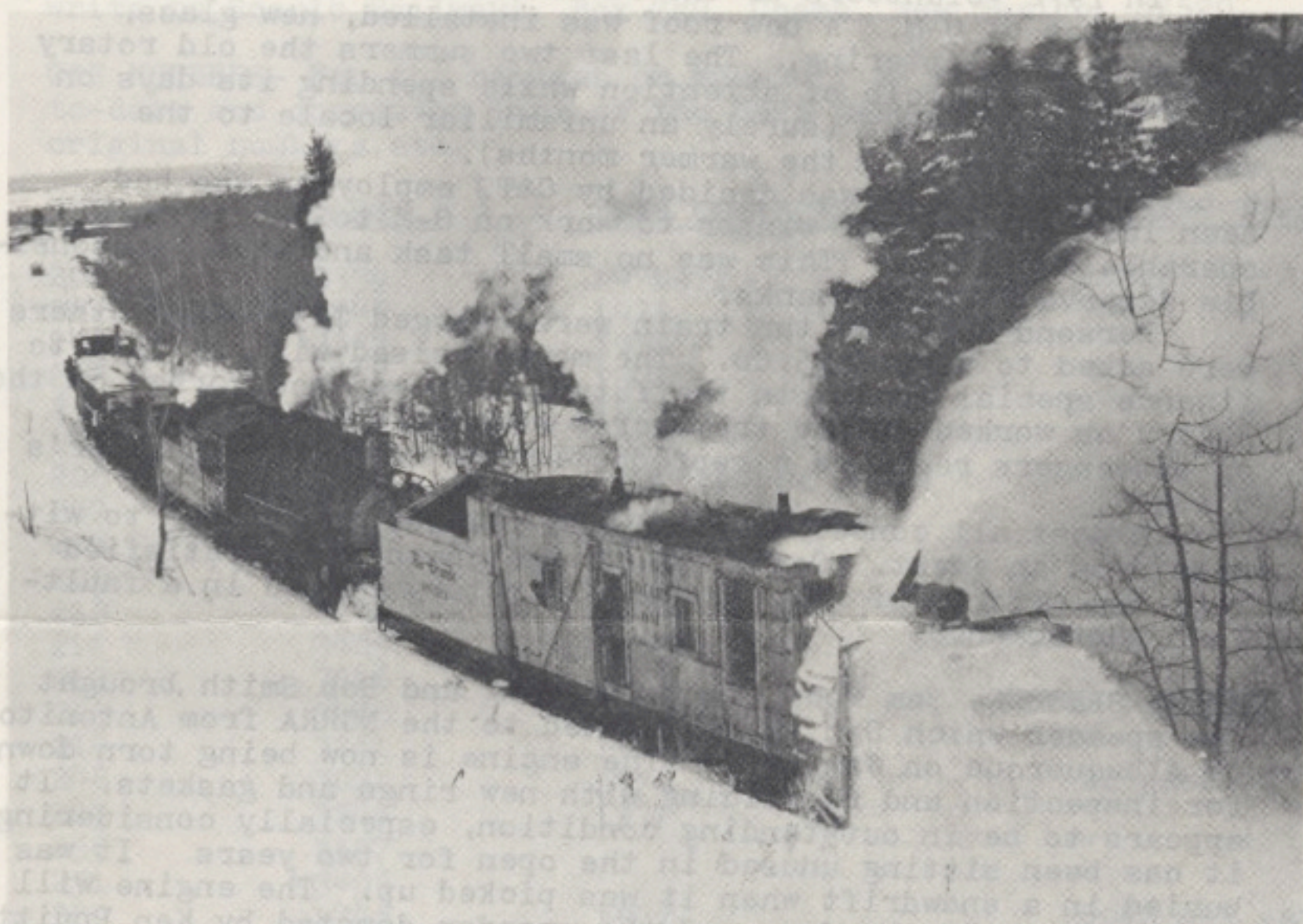

ROTARY O-M STEAMS AGAIN

For the first time in years, the shrill whistle of Rotary Snowplow O-M echoed on the "heights" of Cumbres. Rotary O-M departed Chama under steam at approximately 11:00 A.M. on January 12th, being pushed by the reliable old engine #487.

The event hardly went unnoticed, as persons clogged the highway outside Chama. Fifty tickets to ride the train were sold out. Persons riding the train were treated to several photo runs, made difficult to prospective photographers by the necessity of having to traverse several yards of deep powdered snow. Needless to say, few were discouraged by this minor obstacle as no one wanted to miss this spectacle of narrow gauge railroading.

And what a spectacle! With air pump barking, whistle shrieking, and snow flying, the 85-year-old rotary went to work clearing the line of its blanket of snow. The train progressed only as far as "the narrows", about 4 miles out of Chama, where it was decided to strike a retreat when the rotary became low on coal.

Previously, the operation of a Rotary Snowplow on the pass had been witnessed by few. The reason for this is that whenever a rotary was needed to open the pass, the highway was almost always closed.

The last time the D&RGW used a rotary snowplow over the pass was in March 1962, when Rotary O-Y made a round trip from Alamosa to Chama and return. Engines 483, 487 and 488 were used on this operation (all this equipment is presently owned by the C&TS RR). In the years following, the D&RGW decided to shut down the narrow gauge for the winter rather than run a rotary to clear the line of snow. Therefore the operation of Rotary O-M was the first time in a dozen years that one of the old steam-powered rotaries has lumbered forth to do battle with the elements on Cumbres.

Old O-M had sat for years unused in the Chama yard and as one might imagine, a great deal of work was required to put O-M into operating condition, however few people realize that it was all volunteer labor which accomplished this task.

In 1972 volunteers of the NGRRA undertook the exterior restoration of O-M. A new roof was installed, new glass, new paint and lettering. The last two summers the old rotary has been a spectacle of attention while spending its days on display atop Cumbres (surely an unfamiliar locale to the venerable O-M during the warmer months).

This winter it was decided by C&TS employees who had been laid off for the winter to work on O-M to put it into operable condition. This was no small task and those responsible deserve a hardy thanks.

Persons who rode the train were charged \$25.00 and others were asked to donate \$5.00. The money raised will be used to finance special trains in the future. No one who worked on the rotary or worked on the train crew were paid. Contributors or passengers received a reproduction of O-M's 1889 builder's plate.

Almost all concerned had to be pleased to be able to witness such an event. Certainly no one could be dissatisfied with the efforts of O-M, as the old rotary turned in a faultless performance.

NGRRA SPEEDER- Sam Wood, Gary Breeding and Bob Smith brought the speeder which Dan Pyzel donated to the NGRRA from Antonito to Albuquerque on Jan. 27th. The engine is now being torn down for inspection and rebuilding with new rings and gaskets. It appears to be in outstanding condition, especially considering it has been sitting unused in the open for two years. It was buried in a snowdrift when it was picked up. The engine will be installed in the frame of the speeder donated by Ken Pruitt which is already narrowed. It is also dismantled so if you want to help reassemble it you might give Jerry DeWitt a call at (505)296-2121 or Bob Smith at (505)266-3886.

LAST MINUTE NEWS- Bills have been introduced in the Colorado and New Mexico legislatures to appropriate money for the maintenance of the C&TS Railroad. Each state would appropriate \$100,000 for a total of \$200,000.

At present the New Mexico bill has passed both houses of the legislature and is awaiting the governor's signature, while the Colorado bill is still before the legislature.

Plans for the money include renovation of the Chama and Cresco water tanks, reworking of the Osier water system, work on the depot and enginehouse in Chama, bridge, trestle and track work, etc.

Current activities include the acquisition of historical items, data, and photographs depicting narrow gauge railroading in the Southern Colorado - Northern New Mexico area. Additionally, the NGRAA is involved in the preservation and restoration of railroad equipment for public display.

To assist in the operation of the Cumbres and Toltec Scenic Railroad, NGRAA members serve as car attendants on passenger trains.

The NGRAA solicits additional items of memorabilia for museum display, as well as procurement of financial aid and special talents to assist in the successful accomplishment of NGRAA activities.
